This 32 year old male presented with acute, painful symptoms related to deep recurrent caries into the pulp on tooth #31. A diagnosis of Irreversible Pulpitis/AAP was established and endodontic therapy was recommended. Pre-operative radiographs suggest routine pulpal anatomy.

Upon complete instrumentation a 3rd mesial canal was located under microscopic magnification and sealed with thermo-compaction of gutta-percha and sealer. This 5 canal molar demonstrates the need to routinely check for additional canal systems to ensure the highest probability for endodontic success.
